

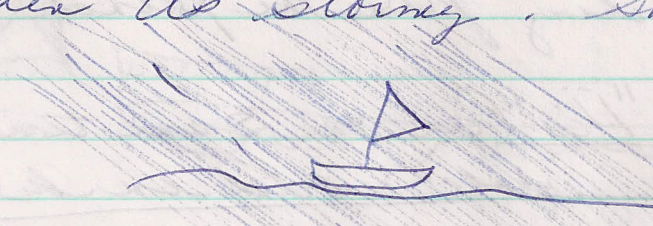

Then the mast on the boat becomes a flag. The flag is showing stripes & colors in motion but I can't make them out. Then it's stormy. Sheets of rain

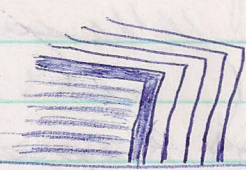


coming down.

big flower

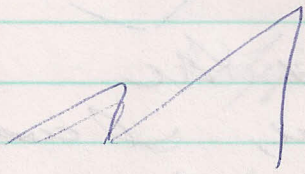
This guy has a longer chin and <sup>or an odd</sup> chin
